





3) Thinking about the past 12 months, which, if any, of the following statements apply to you?






5) What, if any, are the biggest issues related to ASB in this area?



6) If you have not reported ASB to the Council or Police, which, if any, of the following were the reasons for not reporting?






8) Do you think that enough is being done to tackle ASB in this location?




10) Is there anything about this location that makes you feel safe?


11) Good quality lighting makes people feel safe at night. What do you think of the lighting at this location?

- Lads drinking beer in the park in pretty big groups, lots of drug dealing, lots of litter. More visible police is the simple answer.
- Like a lot of littlemore, this area is full of litter and just looks run down. I never see police and rarely see PCSOs, so there's no one to flag ASB to as it's happening. It's an unpleasant area to walk through.
- Some road users should be more careful (slow speed and predictable path)
- It's a nice atmosphere when there are things happening, people hanging out, a party with music in one of the buildings
- Yes. My reason for 'having my say' is that I wanted to raise the issue of parking on the doubleyellow lines on Elm Tree Close and on Cowley Road opposite the shops. I appreciate that most vehicles are parked only briefly to visit the shops, but it still constitutes a nuisance/danger for traffic

and pedestrians. Would CCTV allow fining of vehicles illegally parked? And/or what about the occasional inspection by a traffic warden?

- Littlemore is not a safe or pleasant place to live. Visiting friends in Headington and Summertown provides a stark reminder of how dire it is here. My friends are reluctant to visit me in this area.
- The lane is often full of rubbish and overgrown which makes it an attractive dumping and dealing area.
- Parking in front of the shops needs improvement- so much parking on double yellows. Impossible
 with a pram/wheelchair and dangerous for children. Could some bollards be placed opposite the
 shops to stop parking?
- It's a spooky place especially in the early mornings and at night when it starts to get dark.
- I witness regularly pavement parking -and I mean the whole car is on the pavement outside the post office blocking the pavement

- There is a lot of litter and broken glass under the underpass. Please can you help with this?
- There appears to be a lot of drug related issues in this area. Inaddition, car issues such as the speed of driving on the Cowley Road and parking on double yellow lines blocking the pavement for anyone to walk past, but much worse for disabled passage and pushchair use.
- The area around Little Park and the shops on Cowley Road is seriously neglected and as such attracts those who wish to carry out anti-social acts without fear of being recorded on CCTV or any immediate action being taken when incidents are reported. CCTV under the bypass bridge and on the shops is critical as is improved lighting. The run down state of the shops and flats/rooms above only contribute to the problems (rather than granting permission for more people to live above the shops the council should have condemned the developmen) and a regular police presence is required. Myself and other neighbours are closely involved with the Parish Council, the police, and local councillors to get measures in place as a priority in the area outside the shops and in the park, where large groups frequently congregate to blatantly drink and take drugs and who use this area as a public toilet. Gates which can be locked at night, deterrent fencing and planting, and funded action to transform the park into an area for local children and adults to use and take care of, are

required as a priority to transform the area and take it out of the hands of those who currently use it for anti-social and illegal activities on a daily basis.

- The whole area including the Little Park needs a lot more attention if the ASB is to be controlled. It has been left alone with no one listening for far too long
- The area appears neglected. Blatant drug dealing is a particular problem. I think CCTV coverage is needed to tackle this..
